



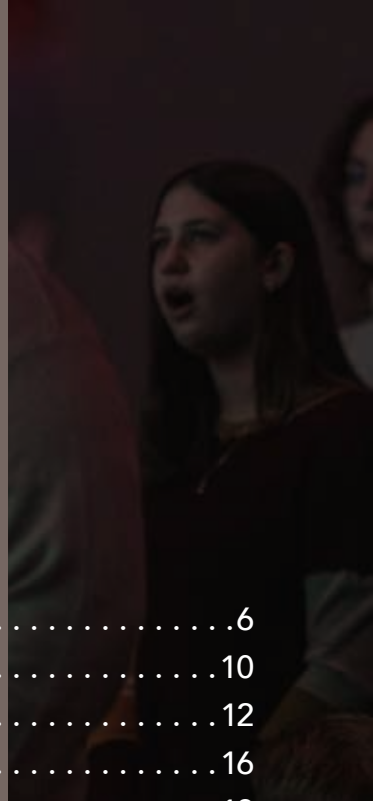

The church wanted to see more lives transformed and multiplied by planting 5 new churches around San Antonio.

For two decades, the church lost focus, leading to a decline in the health of the church and ministry.



2013

The Rebirth

The New Name

God gives us a new name to align with the vision and mission He gave us.



2016

The Walk

Through multiple miracles, God provided almost \$21 million to recreate our Central Campus and to launch and build our Northwest Campus in the Leon Springs Dancehall.



JOURNEY IN GENEROSITY

Generous Spirit

1. INITIAL

Matthew 7:24

An Initial Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time, out of a response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something trusting God and the leaders of the Church with their gift. They experience the initial joy of putting Jesus' words into action.



2. CONSISTENT

2 Corinthians 8:7

Consistent Givers give on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving as a disciple of Jesus. Often, this person makes their gift online a recurring gift; learning the joy of consistency. Non-online givers can be consistent givers it just requires more discipline.



3. PRIORITY

Matthew 6:19-24

Colossians 1:15-20

A Priority Giver understands the pre-eminence of Christ and that He is before all things. This giver places such a significant priority on their giving that it drives their spending and their saving, as opposed to their spending and saving driving their giving. They experience the freedom of serving "one master" and declaring Jesus is first.



4. SURRENDERED

Ephesians 5:1-2

The *Surrendered Giver* recognizes that Christ surrendered His whole self for us, and therefore we desire to surrender our whole selves to Him, in love. This giver would say, "My giving is not just changing my spending and saving, it's also changing me!" They also look at what they're not giving away and ask, "Is it surrendered too?" This guides how they use everything they've been entrusted with – through monetary giving or through a God-honoring use of existing resources.



5. ETERNAL

1 Timothy 6:6-19

This person sees the impact of *Eternal Giving*, for themselves and others, beyond immediate programs and ministries. This giver has been captivated by how generosity and sharing lead to a full life. This encourages them to continue growing! They progress to making all decisions – from major purchases, giving, saving, relationships, even areas of service – in light of how it will make an eternal impact.

Question 1: What excuses have you used to keep from blindly obeying God's call?

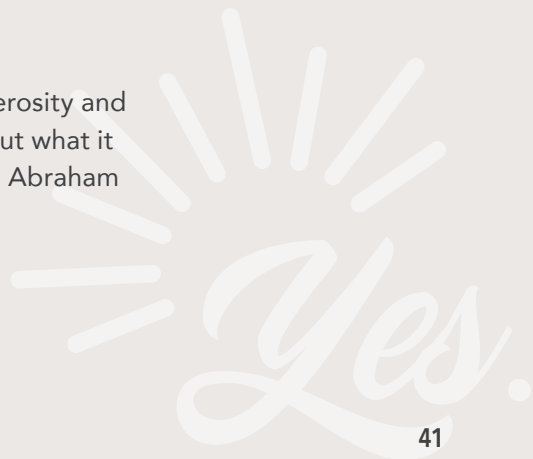
Read Genesis 12:1-3

Question 1: Why is it difficult to trust people? Why do we have so many trust issues?

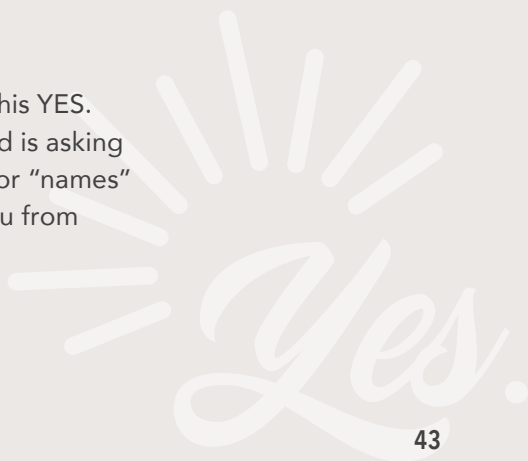
Read Genesis 15:1-6

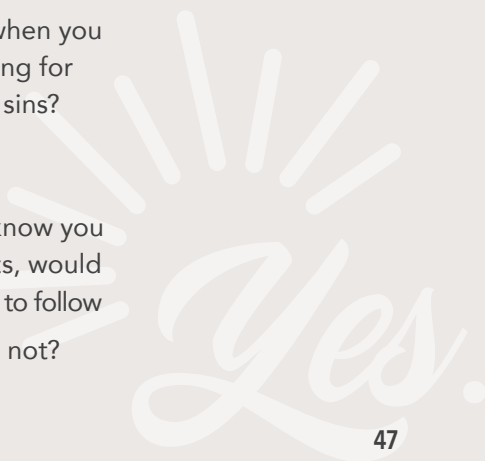

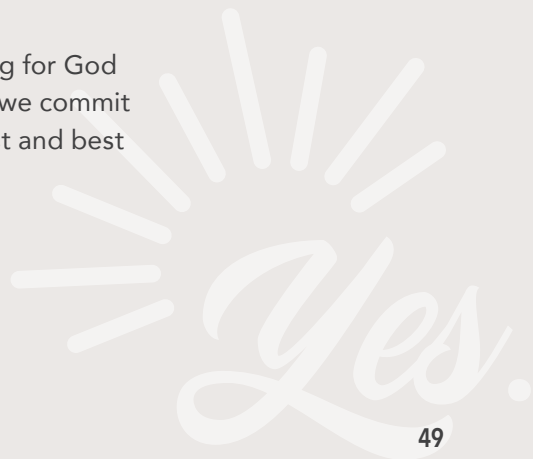

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: If we are committing to YES, how does this change my giving to Go! Missions, the general fund, and other special offerings?

A: During this two-year period, every contribution to God through Mission City Church is a contribution to our YES initiative. This means that everything from our general ministry budget, scholarships, local and global missions, and even campus expansion will be fueled through the YES initiative.

Q: What are you asking me to do?

A: First and foremost, we are asking that you pray and seek God's leading on what He is asking of you. Prepare your heart to hear Him, and then listen to what He says.

Spend time in personal reflection as you walk through this YES Book. Use the sermon notes and discussion guide to dig in deeper with your family, friends, or LifeGroup. Pray through what this commitment will mean for this next exciting season of your life. We are asking that you make a generosity commitment to stretch your faith like never before. Our prayer is that you would give in a way that changes you.

Finally, we ask that you prepare to be amazed. We serve a big God who does big things, and He is going to move in extraordinary ways as we anticipate how He is going to use our collective YES commitments. Plan to be here

for every week of the YES series beginning February 26 and pray about returning your commitment card on Sunday, April 2.

Q: Are there additional ways I can give more toward YES?

A: Be creative as you explore ways you and your family can give toward the YES initiative. You might have some stocks, property, or other stored resources that God has blessed you with and might be calling you to give from during this time. Please let us know if you need assistance with facilitating gifts of property or stock, and we would be happy to help you with that. 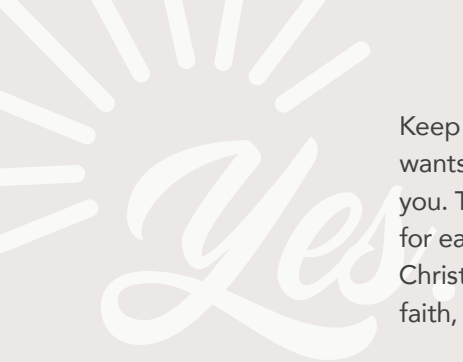
Q: How long is my commitment?

A: We are asking everyone to make a two-year commitment to YES.

Your fulfillment of that commitment will begin in April of 2023 and it will culminate two years later in April of 2025.

Q: What if I am severely in debt right now? Should I still give?

A: If you are someone currently seeking to make payments to pay off debt right now, we commend you for your progress on this important goal. And you should continue to do so. We would be happy to help you find resources to assist you in this journey.



Keep in mind that giving isn't about what God wants from you but rather what He wants for you. The primary goal of the YES initiative is for each of us to grow in our relationship with Christ as He calls us to new levels of surrender, faith, and generosity.

Ask God what that means for you and look for creative ways that you can sacrifice to participate in YES.

Q: What if I am new to Mission City Church?

A: First, we want to say that we are glad you're here! We believe God wants to do something in and through each of us as we step into this next season of YES together. We would love to connect with you and help you find your spot at Mission City Church. Stop by Next Steps on Sunday after the worship service. This is going to be an exciting time at Mission City Church!

Q: What if I haven't been baptized yet?

A: Great question. People take different spiritual steps at different times. Giving is another spiritual discipline that comes at different times for different people. One thing is for sure - just like other spiritual disciplines, giving draws us closer to God. And God is calling ALL of us to give. The Bible says: "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Matthew 6:21). Q: Is YES just about money?



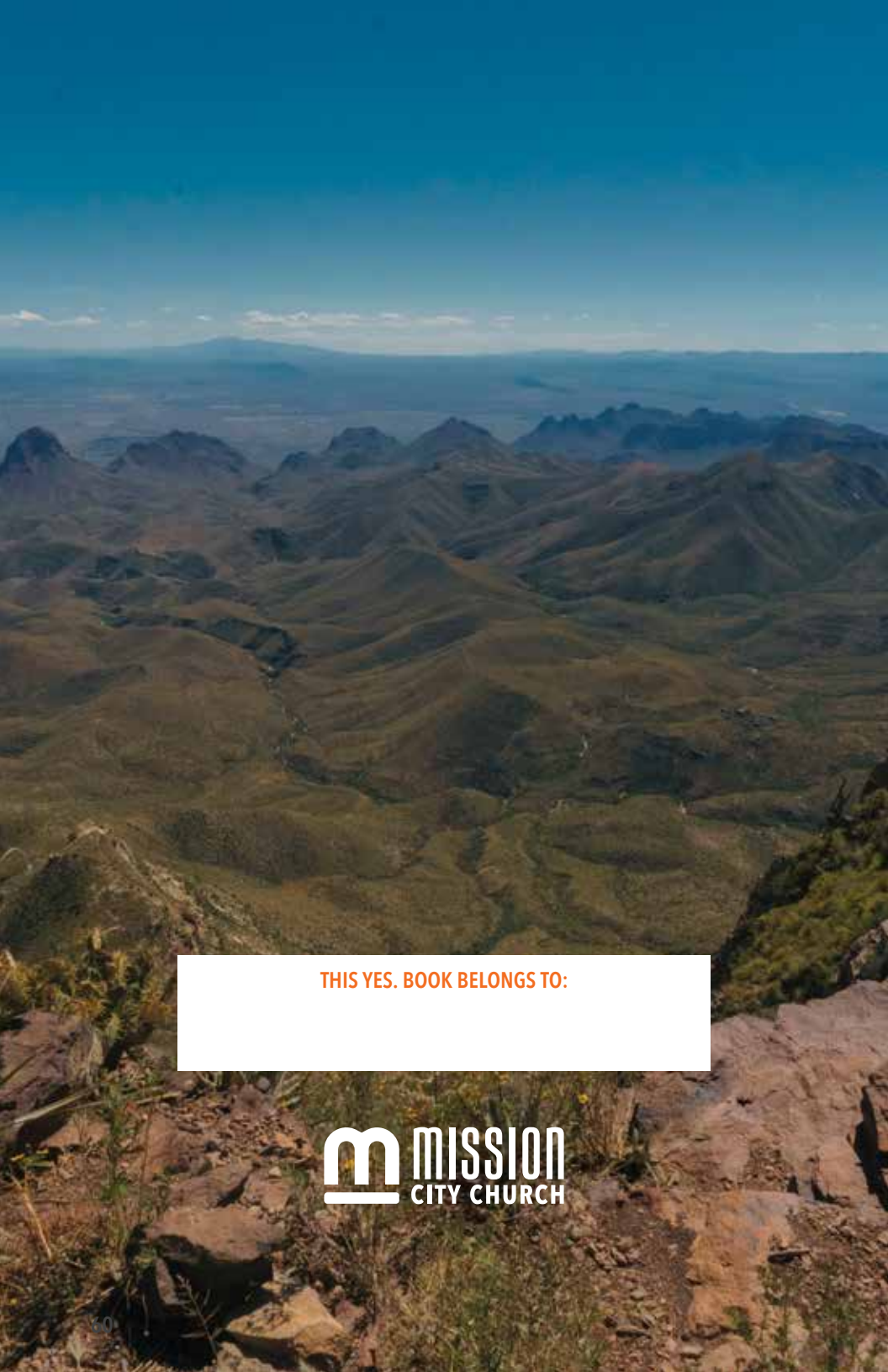
